## Permits and Fees

	<u>Permit Type</u>	<u>Reference</u>	<u>Fee</u>
➤	<b>Blasting Permits</b>	<b>527 CMR 1.12.8.39</b>	<b>\$ 50.00</b>
	Requires valid "Certificate of Competency", Explosives User's Certificate, insurance bond statements, copies of blasters licenses, and a description of the work to be performed. NFPA 1 ch..65		
➤	<b>Cutting &amp; Welding</b>	<b>527 CMR 1.12.8.23</b>	<b>\$ 50.00</b>
	Requires demonstration of a working knowledge of NFPA 1 Ch.41. Must provide a description of the work to be performed and specific location where work will be done. A fire watch shall be provided by company performing work or fire personnel upon request.		
➤	<b>Dumpster Permit</b>	<b>527 CMR 1.12.8.5</b>	<b>\$ 50.00</b>
	Required for dumpsters of six (6) yard capacity or greater. Provide Department with description of dumpster location, name, and telephone number of company or responsible person. NFPA 1 ch.19		
➤	<b>Explosives &amp; Black Powder</b>	<b>527 CMR 1.12.8.50</b>	<b>\$ 25.00</b>
➤	<b>Flammable/Combustible Storage</b>	<b>527 CMR 1.12.8.50.1</b>	<b>\$ 50.00</b>
	Refer to the table in this section for the threshold quantities		
➤	<b>Fire Alarm System Installation/Repair</b>	<b>Fire Alarm Systems</b>	<b>\$ 50.00</b>
	Installation requires submission of plans to the Building Department for a compliance review prior to undertaking work.		
➤	<b>Fire Suppression System (Commercial Kitchen)</b>	<b>527 CMR 1.12.8.30</b>	<b>\$ 50.00</b>
	Installation requires submission of plans to the fire department for a compliance review prior to undertaking work.		
➤	<b>Home Fire Alarm &amp; Carbon Monoxide Alarms</b>	<b>New Construction/Renovation</b>	<b>\$ 50.00</b>
	Call business office to schedule time of inspection (usually requires 24-48 hours' notice). Money order made out to the City of Marlborough can be paid at time of inspection. Inspectors will check smoke detectors, carbon monoxide alarms, and house numbers.		
➤	<b>Oil Burner Equipment Installation/Alteration</b>	<b>527 CMR 1.12.8.2</b>	<b>\$ 50.00</b>
	Installation, alteration, or replacement of an oil burner, tank, and/or fuel line requires a permit and inspection. Refers to NFPA 1 Chapter 11		

➤	<b>Open Air Burning Permit</b>	<b>527 CMR 1.12.8.1</b>	<b>\$ 10.00</b>
	Annually, from January 15th through May 1st. Burning may only be done between the hours of 10AM and 4PM. Burning of leaves or grass is strictly prohibited. Each day the permit holder is required to call and request permission to burn for that day. Permission will be granted based on wind and weather conditions. NFPA 1 Ch.10		
➤	<b>Residential Smoke &amp; Carbon Monoxide Alarms</b>	<b>MGL 148 - 26F, 26F<sup>1/2</sup></b>	<b>\$ 50.00 (per unit)</b>
	Call business office to schedule time of inspection (usually requires 24-48 hours notice). Check or money order made out to the City of Marlborough can be paid at time of inspection. Inspectors will check for smoke detectors, carbon monoxide alarms, and house numbers. <i>* Should your inspection fail, there will be a one time re-inspection fee of \$50.00.</i>		
➤	<b>Site Assessment Request</b>	<b>21E File Review</b>	<b>\$ 50.00 (per address)</b>
	Site Review form must be filled out indicating each street address requested and include map and parcel numbers, if available, to expedite the process. May take 7-10 days for review. Review is based on file review only.		
➤	<b>Smokeless Propellant</b>	<b>527 CMR 1.12.8.50</b>	<b>\$ 25.00</b>
	Shall apply to the transportation and storage of small arms ammunition, primers and components, smokeless propellants, and black powder.		
➤	<b>Sprinkler System Installation/Repair</b>	<b>527 CMR 1.12.8.3</b>	<b>\$ 50.00</b>
	Installation requires submission of 3 sets of plans to the Building Department for compliance review prior to undertaking any work.		
➤	<b>Storage Tank Permit</b>	<b>527 CMR 1.12.8.24</b>	<b>\$ 50.00</b>
➤	<b>Storage Tank Removal – Oil</b>	<b>527 CMR 11.5.1.10.5 (4)</b>	<b>\$ 50.00</b>
➤	<b>Tank Vehicles Parked Overnight</b>	<b>527 CMR 1.12.8.24</b>	<b>\$ 50.00</b>
	Permit renewal required every two years: Any tank truck parked in the city overnight on a regular basis is subject to registration with the fire department and inspection, NFPA 1 ch.42		
➤	<b>Transportation of Combustible Liquids</b>	<b>527 CMR 1.12.8.25</b>	<b>\$ 50.00</b>
	Permit renewal required every two years: Any vehicle with an auxiliary tank is subject to inspection and registration with the fire department. NFPA 1 ch.42		
➤	<b>Unvented Gas Fired Heaters/Fireplaces</b>	<b>527 CMR 1.12.8.6</b>	<b>\$ 50.00</b>
	Refer to NFPA 1 Chapter 20		
➤	<b>Waste Oil Storage Tank (Aboveground)</b>	<b>527 CMR 1.12.8.50</b>	<b>\$ 50.00</b>
