

MINUTES OF THE LICENSE BOARD MEETING HELD APRIL 30, 2014

There was a regular monthly meeting of the License Board held on Wednesday, April 30, 2014 at 7:30 pm, City Hall, 3rd floor, Memorial Hall.

Attending were: Walter Bonin, Chairman; Gregory Mitrakas, Member; Linda Goodwin, Secretary.

Meeting was called to order by Walter Bonin, Chairman at 7:30 pm.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1: MASONIC CORP – CATERING BY TASTY HOME COOKING - 6 - ALL ALCOHOL ONE DAY PERMITS

Ed Walsh presented 6 ALL alcohol one day permit applications. Motion made to approve by Gregory Mitrakas, seconded by Walter Bonin. Motion carried 2-0

- 2: ITAM – OUTDOOR PAVILLION – 3 – ONE DAY ALL ALCOHOL PERMITS

John Manning presented- 3- ALL alcohol one day permits applications for outdoor pavilion at ITAM. Motion made to approve by Gregory Mitrakas, seconded by Walter Bonin. Motion carried 2-0

- 4: VIN BIN – 91 MAIN STREET – SEASONAL ONE DAY PERMIT W/MEDC – 91 MAIN STREET – FRONT OF PROPERTY (RICK LOMBARDI MANAGER; AND MARY SCOTT, MANAGER)

Rick Lombardi present with application for a seasonal one day permit application. This is the same type of seasonal application that they had last year. Portion of proceeds goes towards MEDC for Main Street Restaurant Association. Half of the season Rick Lombardi is the Manager

on record, and the second half of the season Mary Scott is the Manager on record. Serving will be on Friday evenings, Saturday evenings, and Sunday afternoons. Last year we tried it on Thursday's in conjunction with the summer concert series, but we did not draw many on Thursdays. So this year we will try doing Friday, Saturday's and Sunday afternoons. People like to sit out outside on a nice sunny day. We are constantly trying to think of ways to rejuvenate Main Street. The dates will be (1) 5/23/14 thru 7/28/14; (2) 8/1/14 thru 10/5/14.

5: STRANGE BREW – 1 – ONE DAY BEER/WINE PERMIT - TASTING

Brian Powers present with application. This is an annual event, National Brewing Day the first Saturday in June. We will hold a demonstration & tasting set up on the side of our business, area will be roped off, someone is checking id's etc. at the entrance. We had the same event last year with no issues; we expect no issues again this year. Very low keyed, just getting people interested in how it's done. Motion made to approve by Gregory Mitrakas, seconded by Walter Bonin. Motion carried 2-0

6: HORSESHOE PUB – 1 – ONE DAY BEER/WINE – SOLOMON POND MALL EVENT

This is a mall event, and is for Mother's Day. They rope off an area: serve appetizers, wine, etc. Mother's shop, then have a treat, etc. Motion made to approve by Gregory Mitrakas, seconded by Walter Bonin. Motion carried 2-0.

7: BEST WESTERN TRADE CENTER – OUTDOORS - 1 – BEER/WINE – ONE DAY

Arthur Correa Food Manager present for Best Western. We have rented the Trade Center to Bosh Security & part of their program is they want to have a tent outside with truck exhibit, and an acoustic guitar player from 3-5 pm. We will have personnel out there to make sure things run smoothly with no issues. The remainder of the event will be indoors. I have provided an insurance rider for the event, which includes the outdoor portion of the event too. Motion made to approve by Gregory Mitrakas, seconded by Walter Bonin. Motion carried 2-0.

8: MARLBOROUGH HISTORICAL SOCIETY – BEST WESTERN – BREWFEST –
1- BEER/WINE ONE DAY PERMIT

Bob Kane, Vice President of the Historical Society, present with Janet Litch, President of the Historical Society. The Tasting and the Brewfest will be run separately this year. The Chamber of Commerce will be taking over the Tasting. I do not believe there will be an event this year because it is the anniversary of the Chamber and they have several events planned. The Brewfest will be a fundraiser to benefit the Historical Society. The Historical Society needs to raise a serious amount of money to fix this property; our previous lease had huge restrictions and would not for any renovations. The property has been recently purchased by MHQ who is very receptive to altering the terms of the lease and will allow us to do the renovations that are really needed. We have been approved for a State grant that will match the funds we raise to restore this location. We are very excited about this. The Brewfest will be held in two sessions, one in the afternoon and one in the evening. There will be up to 50 brewers; at the Tasting we had about 25 brewers at 3 different locations up and down Main Street. There will be 5 sections, 2-3 police officers. Everyone will be TIPS trained, volunteers will be in place, and we will provide an insurance rider closer to the event. We anticipate no issues, same as the last several years, no events, and no issues. Motion made to approve by Gregory Mitrakas, seconded by Walter Bonin. Motion carried 2-0

9: OLIVE GARDEN – CHANGE OF MANAGER – DAWN BELLEROSE

Dawn Bellerose unable to attend meeting. Board reviewed paperwork, all was in order. Motion made to approve by Gregory Mitrakas, seconded by Walter Bonin. Motion carried 2-0
