**Mayor's Charity Relief Fund to Assist Victims of Lake

MARLBOROUGH – Monday morning's fire at the Lake Williams Condominiums has prompted many city residents to ask how they can help the victims and displaced families.

They need look no further than the Mayor's Charitable Relief Fund.

Since 1960, this emergency fund has assisted local residents in need of a helping hand during times of emergency or duress. This fund may help a family who lost their possessions in a home fire or who are threatened with eviction, senior citizens whose fuel or light and power are to be terminated, or individuals financially struggling due to a serious illness.

The Mayor's fund receives the majority of its income through the Mayor's Charitable Ball which is held every other year. This year's biennial ball takes place on May 5<sup>th</sup> at the Best Western Royal Plaza in Marlborough and tickets may be purchased through the Mayor's office.
