

Adopt-A-Space



Now that spring is upon us, the City of Marlborough reminds residents and businesses that the Adopt-a-Space program for the maintenance and beautification of landscaped areas, traffic islands and other green space owned by the City is open to old and new participants alike. Mayor Arthur Vigeant started this program in 1998 when he was a City Councilor. Arthur Vigeant sought approval of a public/private venture to assist the City in its spring cleanup and landscape beautification efforts.

Any company, organization, or person who wishes to adopt a space in the City will be asked to maintain the adopted area for the spring, summer and fall seasons. This will include spring and fall cleanup and plantings, if appropriate, and require mulching, weeding and watering. We will provide a sign with your name at your adopted area indicating that you have adopted this space. Like the "Blooming Bucket" program, we hope that enthusiasm and competition among businesses and individuals will result in unique beautification efforts across the City. We will work with you to coordinate the adoption of an area, including traffic islands, public monuments, roadside embankments and other green or landscaped areas. We urge businesses, residents and civic organizations to join this year's **ADOPT-A-SPACE**. Let your imagination and civic pride shine through in your efforts to make your "adopted" area the best in the City!
