City Engineer Recommendation: The pole should be placed within the city layout. The back of the sidewalk is the edge of the public property (i.e. city layout). No disturbance should be made on private property without permission from private property owner. Also, 48 inches shall be maintained from the front of the proposed pole to the back of the curbing on Church Street.
