**MAYOR J. CHRISTIAN DUMAIS ISSUES UPDATED STATEMENT  
REGARDING UMASS MEMORIAL MEDICAL CENTER –  
MARLBOROUGH CAMPUS**

**MARLBOROUGH, MA** - Mayor J. Christian Dumais announces that as of this morning, February 12<sup>th</sup>, Marlborough Hospital has moved out of Code Black status and is now open, with patients returning to the facility. The Massachusetts Department of Public Health, along with the City's Building and Code Enforcement Team, has been on site to conduct inspections and ensure all safety and building code requirements were met. Based on these reviews, the hospital has been deemed safe for patients, staff, and visitors to resume medical services and normal operations.

“Again, I want to express my sincere gratitude for the professionalism and dedication shown throughout this response,” said Mayor Dumais. “Our top priority was the safe and timely reopening of the hospital, and I am proud that services were able to resume quickly so our community could continue to receive the care it depends on.”
