All cases reported here are confirmed PCR positive cases as reported through the Massachusetts Virtual Epidemiologic Network (MAVEN) and may understate the actual prevalence of COVID-19 in the community.

The new definition reduces the timeframe from 60 to 30 days. DPH State Epidemiologist Dr. Catherine Brown said Massachusetts adopted the definition because the department supports the need to standardize how COVID-19 deaths are counted.





Trends of Confirmed Coronavirus Cases in the City of Marlborough (03/14/2022)











