What to expect if you have been tested for Covid-19:

- The results from your test are reported to the ordering doctor on the lab form.
- Because this is a reportable infectious disease, positive results are also sent to the State Department of Public Health who in turn reports them to the Local Board of Health where you live.
- This reporting is good because you will now get a call from the Public Health Nurse or one of the School Nurses that are helping during this outbreak.
- We will talk to you about isolation and ask you questions about with whom you have had contact. This is extremely confidential information, and we take it very seriously to keep it that way.
- Your help in this process helps to get people who may need to be tested identified and to ensure you have the services you need to stay in isolation or quarantine.
- Thank you for helping to keep Marlborough safe!!!
