

Built in 1965 as the City of Marlborough's 667-2 State Elderly Project, 397 Bolton Street was rededicated to serving the elderly veterans of Marlborough in October of 2015, marking the end of over two (2) years of construction and over \$2 million of improvements. These improvements include brand new HVAC heating and cooling units, expanded parking with fifty-two (52) spaces for residents, three (3) handicapped parking spaces, and six (6) visitor spots, new walkways and curbing, upgraded fire alarms, and an upgraded community room all completed in 2015. The roofs of each building were replaced in 2010.
