“SCRPT”

Senior Citizen Residential Property Tax Work-Off Program FY’24

The City of Marlborough values the wealth of skills and knowledge possessed by its senior residents. The “SCRPT” program provides seniors the opportunity to share their skills in service to the community and receive up to a \$1,000 abatement on their property taxes. The success of the program depends on the co-coordinated efforts of the various city departments requesting services, the program co-coordinator who matches the volunteers, the Assessor’s office that administers the abatement process and the Treasurer’s office where payments are submitted.

Attached is the application and related documents that must be completed and **returned in person to the Marlborough Senior Center by Friday, February 17th by 4:00pm**. Please complete and sign the SCRPT application. Please bring your license or other government issued ID with you for submission. We recommend that you call in advance to be sure a staff person who can verify the CORI information will be available to accept your packet. Please keep the first two pages of this packet for your information.

If there are more applicants than jobs available a lottery drawing will be held on Monday, March 20th at 10:30am. (You do not need to be present.)

The SCRPT program will run from April – June and then again from September – November. (We will try but cannot guarantee to accommodate requests for participation in Spring or Fall session.)

- Applicant is over the age of 60
- Applicant has lived in the City for at least 5 years
- Applicant may participate only once in a calendar year
- Only one applicant per household
- Applicant must own home
- Applicant’s home is primary residence
- will run from March – June and then again from September – December.
