

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

The City of Marlborough ("City"), the Awarding Authority, invites ELECTRONIC BIDS (E-Bids) from contractors for the **Reconstruction of Memory Lane and Forbes Avenue and Appurtenant Work in Marlborough, Massachusetts, CONTRACT NO. ED 2020-03** for the Department of Public Works-Engineering Division in accordance with the documents prepared by the City of Marlborough. The project consists of roadway reconstruction including the replacement of hma berms, sidewalks and wheelchair ramps. This work shall also include all labor, material and equipment necessary to complete the work. The estimated project cost is approximately \$415,232.99. **Bidders must be prequalified by the MassDOT Highway Division** pursuant to M.G.L. c. 81, §8B. Bids are subject to M.G.L., c. 30, §39M, and to minimum wage rates as required by M.G.L. c. 149, §26 through 27H inclusive. Bid documents are available as of 9:00 AM on **Wednesday, April 1, 2020**. The project documents must be obtained by following these instructions: "Go to www.Projectdog.com and click "Sign Up" for free, or login with your existing account. Enter Project Code **837925** in the project locator box. Select "Acquire Documents" to download bid documents. All questions and answers shall be distributed as an addendum to all on record as having received the bid documents. **This project is being Electronically Bid (E-Bid)**. Each bid must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the amount of 5% of the total contract price including any alternates.
