

The system of rectangular coordinates is that of the MASSACHUSETTS SYSTEM extended easterly. The origin of this system has geographic coordinates, Lat. 42° 12' 30" N., Long. 71° 04' 34.6" W. and plane coordinates: North 51,779.65, East 30,131.46.
Elevations given for water surfaces of reservoirs are those of the slope grade or the spillways.
