## Adopt-A-Planter Program Announces 2019 Season

The City of Marlborough announces the availability 2019 Adopt-A-Planter Program applications.

**Adopt-A-Planter**, a variation of the Adopt-A-Space program initiated in 1999 by Mayor Vigeant in his role as City Councilor, was created to address the changing needs of our community, its members and businesses. Busy lives and anticipated summer water restrictions inspired the creation of the Adopt-A-Planter program. The affordable program has been designed as a low maintenance initiative to engage the community in the beautification of Main Street.

Participants of the program adopt planters and leave the on-going gardening up to the City. All planters throughout Marlborough will contain uniformed easy maintenance plantings. The cost of adoption is just \$100 and includes the use of a 28" wide x 28" high commercial planter, as well as the plants and a plaque noting the committed adopter's name(s) or company(ies).

"City programs like Clean Sweep and Adopt-A-Planter provide great opportunities for residents and businesses to show our Marlborough pride and engage in the beautification of our City. Each year participation in these programs grows and the entire city benefits." says Mayor Vigeant.
