Did you know?

The library offers print services! You can either come to the library to print documents, or you can send us your file from home via our website. If sending from home, you'll need to



come to the library during our open hours to retrieve if from the print release station. You can also email your print job to us from a mobile device. Prints cost 15¢ per page for black and white, and 25¢ for color. The machine takes one dollar bills and silver coins. No credit card capacity.

Feel free to come to the library to use our public computers to print. To send a document from home via our website, go to www.marlboroughpubliclibrary.org and click the printer icon in the upper right of the home page. Follow the directions to upload and send your document to the printer. Then you're all set to come to the library to release it from the Print Release Station. Staff are happy to help if needed.

To print an email message or attachment from a mobile device, simply forward your email to marlborough-bw@printspots.com for black and white prints, or to marlborough-color@printspots.com for color prints. Come to the library and release the print job.

Print services are offered for up to 30 pages maximum. For larger print jobs, please contact a local store.
