- Be sure to include the book's title and reference passages in the book to events in your life.
- The essay must be your own original work, not previously submitted for classwork. The essay must be 500 words or less, typed, double-spaced, with 1" margins. Attach this application form to your essay. Your name should not appear on your essay.
- No transcript or grades required.
- A committee from the Marlborough Public Library Board of Trustees will read all the essays and choose one winner or multiple winners at their discretion.
