Mr. Thebado gave the following Recreation Department updates:

- Introduced and welcomed Joe Mulvey as the new program manager
- Street Hockey Program will begin Sunday, Feb 21st here at Ghiloni Park
- Sign-ups are still ongoing for the second winter session of the Ice-Skating Program which will begin the 1st week of March
- Started Spring Central Mass E-Sports league sign-ups this week. League begins Monday April 12th. For Grades 3-12 and Adult leagues are being offered as well. We had 11 sign-ups for the winter session.
- Started posting spring programs on website. Will be offering Flag Football, a 2nd session of street hockey, Pre-K Mini-Sports, Pre-K Soccer, and a weeklong Ultimate Sports program for kids ages 7-12. Joe is working on additional programming and will update next meeting.
- Meeting with PSA Director Rick Cincotta next week to discuss options in regard to COVID- State Guidelines for Spring Vacation and Project Summer program.
- Scouted city parking lots with Chris White to view potential locations (Quest Diagnostics / Hilton Garden, The Campus, Fidelity, Assabet Valley High School and Whitcomb Middle School) for Drive-In Movies. Had preliminary discussions and quotes with FunFlicks to schedule for mid-late May.
- Meeting with Mayor Vigeant next week to discuss upcoming FY 22 Budget
- Summer Concert Series scheduling is still ongoing, should have set schedule for next meeting.

• Spoke with Sudbury Recreation and we will be setting up lifeguard training classes for the spring / early summer before our aquatic facilities open.
