Parks Report:

Mr. White gave the following Parks update:

- Fields are open for the season we opened all fields last week.
- Playground inspections are done we disinfect all bathrooms every morning.
- We started last week cutting grass at the downtown area and continuing with the rest of the city parks and fields.
- We marked all fields once leagues will be responsible for the rest of the season to mark their field.
- All our equipment are in good shape.
- We are in the process to complete our budget for the next fiscal year.

Recreation Report..... Charles Thebado, Director:

Mr. Thebado gave the following Recreation Department updates:

- We are working with Rick Cincotta to finalize our summer program. It's going to run a little different to what we have done in the past due to COVID guidelines. The Summer Program will be for ages 6-10 years old, and will run from 9am 3pm., for three two week sessions at Hildreth School. We will divide 40 kids which is our maximum into four different groups with two counselors to a group.
- Simela has finalized the Summer Concerts Series, which will run depending on budget approval and state COVID guidelines.
- Boat Ramp will open on Memorial Day weekend. All key holders have been notified as well. We need to make a decision regarding opening and closing guidelines for the boat ramp.
- Simela is doing an outstanding job in regards to field permitting. There have been some issues but we have dealt with them.
- Meeting with Dennis Mannone and Steve Santos tomorrow at Sudbury Recreation to formulate a lifeguard training course for our three towns.
- Spring programs are finalized and ready to start later this month. Joe and I, will be working on additional summer programming and should have everything in place for next month's Commission meeting.
- Spoke with Priscilla Ryder regarding grants.
- We are anticipating to open the splash pads early June.

The Commission thanked Mr. Thebado for his report.
