- Standard Sticker and Senior Citizen/DAV Sticker allows disposal of 50 household bags and 6 Pay Items. Sticker Upgrades for 4 additional pay items are \$100. Personal checks or money orders only (no cash payments). 12 additional household bags are considered 1 pay item. Household bags are up to 40 gallons in size. Recycling sticker is free.
- Eligible vehicles are cars, vans, and pickup trucks. Ineligible vehicles are pickup trucks
 with sideboards, dump trucks, box trucks, large cargo vans, dump trailers, vehicles
 displaying a business logo (vinyl and/or magnetic signage) and others not deemed to
 follow Facility Rules & Regulations.
- Stickers will be affixed to, and shall remain on, the lower left-hand windshield corner. A stickered vehicle is allowed 1 sticker transfer per year.
- A stickered vehicle is allowed 4 unstickered surrogate vehicle loads per year. Stickered vehicle must be present on property while surrogate vehicle is being used.
- Materials <u>not</u> accepted at the drop-off facility are <u>demolition loads</u>, paints, stains, hazardous waste and others not deemed to follow Facility Rules & Regulations.
- Maximum load size is 5 feet by 8 feet by 2 feet. Heaped loads will not be accepted.
- Bulk Waste Pay Item: One load of bulk waste not exceeding maximum load size.
- <u>Electronics Pay Item:</u> One load of electronic waste with no more than one TV/Monitor.
- Appliance Pay Item: One appliance.
- Mattress Box Spring Pay Item: One mattress or box spring.
- No scavenging is allowed anywhere on the property.
- Yard waste shall be separated and disposed of in appropriately marked areas. Brush and branches must be 8 inches or less in diameter and less than 4 feet in length. Yard waste shall be emptied from both plastic and biodegradable bags before disposing.
- Violating facility rules and regulations, not following attendant's directions, disposing of commercial/business waste or acting in an uncivilized/belligerent manner will result in revocation of Drop-Off Facility privileges.
