Communication from Marc Kantor/ Marlborough Youth Baseball regarding proposal for a new infield at Martinangelo Field/Williams Street.

MYBA representative Chuck Brooks presented the proposal to the Commission, stating the new infield at Martinangelo would enhance the Williams Street complex and also allow MYBA to attract teams and organizations from out of town for tournament play in the future.

MYBA will be responsible for the cost of the installation included in the quote, as well as many additional items that will be needed, such as new home plates, new pitching rubbers, and professional grade tarps. The installation would be done in the fall of 2018 and would be ready for use in April of 2019.

As with Langelier, MYBA will also take responsibility for the necessary annual maintenance and material that would be required with this new infield. Both the vendor and MYBA will work closely with the Marlborough Department of Public Works to ensure that the new field is maintained properly.
