Notice is given that the Marlborough City Council & the Marlborough School Committee will meet in Joint Convention to elect a replacement for Mark A. Walter who has resigned. Said replacement will fill the balance of Mr. Walter's term which runs through December 31, 2019.

Per Section 36 of the Marlborough City Charter, if a vacancy occurs in the School Committee by failure to elect, or otherwise, the City Council and the remaining members of the School Committee shall meet in joint convention and elect a suitable person to fill the vacancy until the first Monday in January following the next regular municipal election; and if there would be a vacancy on said first Monday, it shall be filled at such regular municipal election for the balance of the unexpired term. The Mayor, if present, shall preside at the convention.

School Committee Vacancy - Applications Requested

Mayor Arthur Vigeant has set Monday, February 25, 2019 at 7 pm, as the date of the Joint Meeting of the City Council and School Committee for the purposes of filling the vacancy on the School Committee created by the resignation of Mark Walter on January 11, 2019. The Joint Convention will take place in the City Council Chambers in Marlborough City Hall.

Since Mr. Walter's term was scheduled to expire this year, the seat will be on the ballot for the November 2019 municipal election for a full four-year term. The appointment to fill this vacancy is made at a Joint Convention of the members of the City Council and the members of the School Committee, which includes the Mayor as School Committee Chairman.
