A public hearing will be held by the Marlborough Community Development Authority on **Wednesday, January 22, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.** to discuss the City's proposed grant application to the **Massachusetts Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) for funding from its FY 2020 Community Development Fund (CDF) Program**, to report on the progress of the current FY 2018 CDBG programs, and to discuss community development needs and issues facing the city. The City is planning to request FY 2020 CDBG funds to continue the City's housing rehabilitation program, support the modernization of Marlborough Housing Authority facilities, social services to support the City's youth and/or address other unmet community development needs. The grant application may request funding for the aforementioned activities and/or other CDBG-eligible activities. If funded, the grant will be administered by the Marlborough Community Development Authority. The City encourages a broad spectrum of participation by residents and other interested parties in order to better understand and serve the needs of the community. Any person or organization so wishing will be afforded an opportunity to be heard.
