COVID-19 Essential Services Emergency Order

Today, Governor Charlie Baker issued an emergency order requiring all businesses and organizations that do not provide “COVID-19 Essential Services” to close their physical workplaces and facilities to workers, customers and the public as of **Tuesday, March 24th at noon until Tuesday, April 7th at noon.**

Businesses that provide essential services include, but are not limited to, grocery stores, convenience stores, pharmacies, health care facilities, public safety, law enforcement, transportation, financial services, and public works. Restaurants, bars, and other establishments that sell food and beverage products to the public are encouraged to continue to offer food for take-out and by delivery.
