Massachusetts Income Tax Deadline Extended

The 2019 Massachusetts individual income tax filing and payment deadline was **extended today from April 15 to July 15** due to the ongoing COVID-19 outbreak. This income tax relief is automatic, and taxpayers do not need to file any additional forms to qualify.

Marlborough Transfer Station Update

Marlborough residents **without a sticker** are now allowed to dispose of bagged yard waste, household trash and recycling at the Resident Drop Off Facility (Transfer Station) for the **month of April**. Residents must show their vehicle registration and driver's license (both bearing the same Marlborough address) by holding them against the closed car window.

This allowance is for yard waste (four biodegradable bags per day), household trash (one garbage bag per day), and recycling only. Stickers are required for the disposal of bulk waste, electronic waste, appliances and other waste. Stickers purchased now are good until June 30, 2020.
