Marlborough Water and Sewer Billing Update

To ease concerns regarding water/sewer service invoicing, The City of Marlborough will extend the due date of **March and April Water and Sewer Utility Bills by 60-days.** Bills originally due in March are now due on the same date in May and bills originally due in April are now due on the same date in June.

To pay bills online, go to https://www.marlborough-ma.gov/collectors-office/pages/pay-bills-online. Alternatively, you can place bills in the drop box located in the front and rear of City Hall at 140 Main Street.

Transfer Station Update

The City is allowing all residents without a sticker to dispose of bagged yard waste, household trash and recycling at the 856 Boston Post Road East Resident Drop Off Facility (Transfer Station) through the month of April. Residents must show their vehicle registration and driver's license both bearing the same Marlborough address. There is no need to roll down your window when showing your registration and license, just hold them against the car window for the attendants to view. This allowance is for yard waste (four biodegradable bags per day), household trash (one garbage bag per day) and recycling ONLY.

If you are looking to dispose of bulk waste, electronic waste, appliances then you will need to purchase a sticker. The resident drop-off facility is currently operating under normal business hours of 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Saturday

MPS Meal Continuity Plan
