Changes to Marlborough Public Schools Meal Continuity Plan

Beginning Monday, April 6, the Marlborough Public Schools Meal Continuity Plan will **switch from daily service to service on only Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays**. All families will receive **extra meals** on these days to cover the days that the busses will not be running (Tuesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays, and Sundays). The neighborhood bus stops will remain the same, and service times will remain at 8:30 AM for breakfast service and 11:45 AM for lunch service.

All Marlborough families are eligible to participate in this program. Meals are available at no charge for anyone who is 18 years old or younger.
