City of Marlborough COVID-19 Update

June 10, 2020

Re-Opening Procedures

Today, Mayor Arthur Vigeant and Public Health Director John Garside provided an update on the outbreak of COVID-19 and re-opening efforts in the City of Marlborough.

- Yesterday, Mayor Vigeant signed an Executive Order authorizing local restaurants to provide outdoor table service in accordance with COVID-19 related orders and guidelines from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. City of Marlborough establishments will be able submit a request for expansion of outdoor table service through the mayor's office. The first round of 20-applicants was approved at the June 9th meeting of the Marlborough Licensing Board.
- The Marlborough Public Library will begin offering contactless pickup service starting June 15, 2020. Requests for material can be made online through CW MARS library accounts at <http://catalog.cwmars.org/eg/opac/home> or by calling the library at 508-629-6900 for assistance. The Library will notify you when your materials are ready. Pickup hours are 10-12 or 2-4, Monday through Friday by appointment.
- Marlborough's wide variety of playgrounds, recreational fields, and courts will re-open on June 10, 2020. Residents that choose to use these facilities must adhere to social distancing guidelines, sanitize hands before and after play and not share equipment. Activities must be non-contact or passive activities such as tennis and pickleball. Additionally, contact sports where play puts players into contact or close proximity to one another, including, football, baseball, softball, soccer, field hockey, and lacrosse are not permitted at this time.
- Splashpad at Ghiloni Park will open once the construction on the parking lot is completed, likely Monday June 15, 2020.
- The Labor Day Parade has been canceled, there are ongoing discussions regarding a smaller event that may be announced at a later date.
