### **Free Masks at Marlborough Food Pantry**

Beginning today, The City of Marlborough is offering free masks to residents. Pickup at the Marlborough Food Pantry, Walker Building, 255 Main Street. Hours for pickup are Tuesdays and Thursdays 10:00 AM – 1:00 PM. Park on the Rawlins Ave side of the building and stay in your car, the staff will deliver to your window. Thanks for helping to keep us safe!

### **COVID-19 Outdoor Precautions and Seasonal Pool Closings**

Although residents are encouraged to spend time outdoors, please follow social distancing guidelines, including wearing a face covering and staying six feet apart when outside of your home, including while playing sports and going for walks. Below is a list of the summertime recreational facilities set to close in the coming weeks

- Wading pools will be open through Sunday, August 23, 2020.
- The Farrell Pool will be open through Wednesday, August 26, 2020
- Memorial Beach is open through Sunday, August 30, and will reopen for Labor Day Weekend.

### **Stop the Spread Update**

Since the announcement of the "Stop the Spread" Program, thousands of people have been tested at one of the three testing locations in Marlborough. Residents can still be tested by Marlborough Hospital by lining up at the Whitcomb Middle School located at 25 Union Street, Marlborough, and by appointment only at AFC Urgent Care located on 38 Boston Post Road West. However, the mobile testing unit has moved its appointment only operations to 402 Hudson Street (enter Gikas Lane into GPS for directions).
