MARLBOROUGH – Today, Mayor Arthur Vigeant and Collector Eileen Bristol have announced that the City of Marlborough will delay the date in which motor vehicle excise demand fees are applied until **Thursday**, **April 30**, **2020**. Motor Vehicle excise bills were due on March 20, 2020, with a \$15.00 demand fee set to be applied on March 27, 2020.

"During difficult and trying times, providing relief to the residents of Marlborough is the main objective of my office, city staff, and the city council. Extending the excise demand deadline is just one way to be of assistance while staying within the guidelines of the law." Said **Mayor Arthur G. Vigeant.**
