The construction site has changed a lot this past month. The steel skeleton has made a big difference. You can actually see the form of the library taking shape. For those of us working closely with the design, it's now easier to imagine what each space will be once construction is complete. When I look at the site from the Witherbee side I can better visualize the children's space which will run from that side of the building to the West Main Street side.

The mockup wall is also taking shape on the West Main Street side of the building. This is the wall that displays samples of all the exterior elements, including brick, stone, and glass. It serves as a reference for the construction workers and provides a preview to the public on the building finishes.

Work on the steel will continue into early June. The General Contractor is preparing a time lapse video that we will post to show the entire steel installation process from start to finish.
