The studding for the rooms on the first and second floor is almost complete. This will allow the exterior walls to take shape and will eventually provide the surface for the sheet rock on the interior walls. You get a real sense of the flow of the building with the studding in place.

Progress continues to be made on the outside sheathing.

The winter enclosure will soon follow allowing for temporary heating so that real progress can be made indoors throughout the winter. Temporary lighting has also been installed since it will be dark while work continues.

The building foundation was recently referred to as "a work of art placed in a cavity chipped out of Marlborough ledge". Workers swear that it's the hardest ledge they have ever seen. Another thing Marlborough will forever be famous for!
