Library Update: Museum Passes

Museums and parks are starting to reopen, but **not all are accepting library passes at this time**. However, a select few are now available to reserve [here](#). Here's what you need to know before reserving a pass:

- Each individual location has a different process and you may be required to register at their site **before your visit**. For details, please be sure to click on the name of the pass you would like to reserve.



- Most passes will need to be picked up via **Contactless Holds Pickup** appointment. The library is not currently open on the weekends, so you will need to plan ahead to pick up a Saturday or Sunday pass.
