


Books That Spark Conversation

The Library is still closed to the public, but we can now offer Contactless Holds Pickup! Pickup hours are 10-12 or 2-4, Monday-Friday by appointment. Here's how it works:

- Put items on hold using your <u>CWMARS account</u>. At this time, we can only fill requests for available Marlborough items.
- Wait for an email, text, or phone call notification that your item(s) are ready to be picked up.
- Book a pickup appointment window <u>here</u> or by calling us at (508) 624-6900.
- Come to the parking lot/Witherbee Street entrance of the library during your appointment window. Your checked out items and due date slip will be in a closed paper bag with your name on it.
