Dear Chief Leonard, what would it take to have a no parking anytime signs posted on Middle street? I live at 3 Middle street the property is in my wife's name Kirti Withrow. Our neighbor Sarah Lewis of 1 Middle street and her husband Ralph Bissonnette just had their driveway repaved about 1 week ago. Ralph owns a green Dodge 2500 series pick-up truck with a severely cracked windshield and is constantly parking it on Middle street. Even before they repaved their driveway; one reason he does this is because he works on his equipment (I have photos to prove this) and it has created quite a spillage of oil and grease on the street.


He also goes back and forth to the truck a lot and this gets my dogs barking because they get the impression he's an intruder. The dogs have been better because they are desensitized to him lately. He use to have commercial plates attached, but changed them to residential once we (the neighborhood) got in touch with the code enforcement officer Pamela Wilderman. Mr Bissonnette is in the tree business and would constantly park his truck with equipment attached (stump grinder, tree shredder) to the rear of the pick-up and leave it on Middle street. I have seen him with his stump grinder attached to the pick-up with the residential plates driving on Francis street, but he won't park on Middle street anymore. When Mr. Bissonnette parks on Middle street this could prevent any large emergency vehicles such as firetrucks and ambulances from going up Middle street. I would appreciate any advice as to how we can make Middle street a no parking anytime street.


Crash Diagram:

Crash Narrative:

Vehicle 1 was traveling E/B through the intersection of Weed ST @ Florence St when it failed to yield right of way at the intersection. Vehicle 1 hit vehicle 2 on the passenger side, causing vehicle 2 to role over onto the drivers side. The operator of vehicle 2 was cut out of the vehicle and transported to Marlborough Hospital for minor injuries. Both vehicles were towed from the crash scene by Central ST Towing and the operator of vehicle 1 was issued a citation.
