

Background

Mayor Arthur G. Vigeant intends to appoint two members from the Class of 2017 to serve as appointees on the City of Marlborough Youth Commission.

The mission of the Marlborough Youth Commission is to enhance the quality of life for City youth through: an ongoing assessment of needs; evaluation of programs provided by the City, private sector and nonprofit organizations; and recommendations regarding changes in programming designed to better meet the needs of the city's youth.

Who Should Apply?

Students from Marlborough that are members of the Class of 2017 and willing to be an active participant on the Commission. Students from all schools are encouraged to apply.

What is the time commitment?

The Youth Commission typically meets once a month in the evening. The day of the week differs from month to month depending on the schedules of all the members. The length of the appointment will last for one year from the date of appointment at which time two new members of the rising junior class will be appointed.

What is the process for applying?

All students will be interviewed by the Mayor's Office in partnership with the Youth Commission. The two students deemed best qualified to contribute will then be asked to appear before the City Council's Personnel Committee, following the same process for all appointments made by the Mayor of Marlborough.
